

# **DRESS POLICY**

## **Policy Objectives**

### Following is acceptable:

- 1. Hair done nicely and tied.
- 2. Dress ironed.
- 3. Shoes polished or washed.
- 4. Traditional dresses.

## Not accepted:

- 1. Leaving hair undone.
- 2. Ripped clothes.
- 3. Short dresses.
- 4. Uncut nails.
- 5. Make ups.
